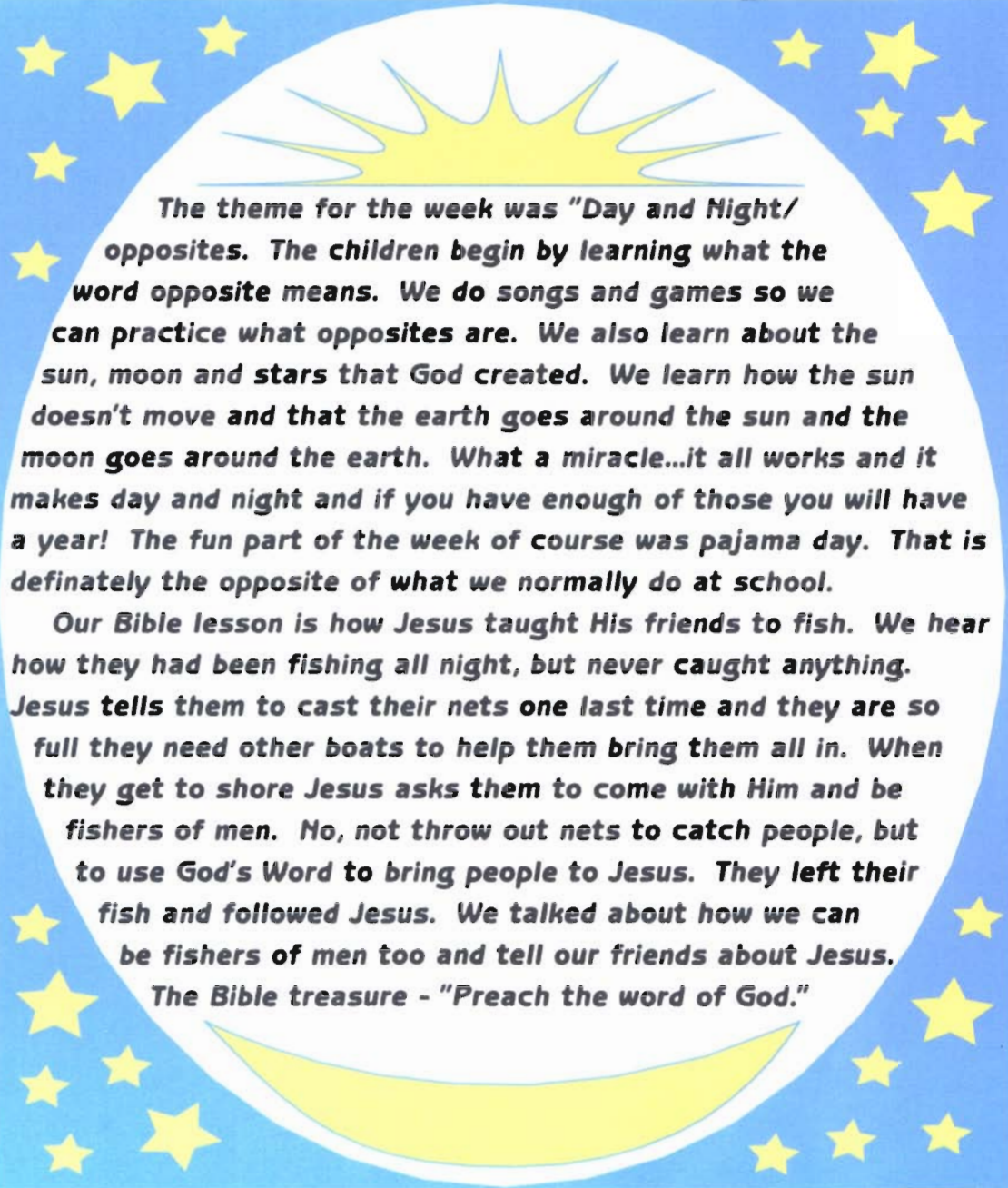
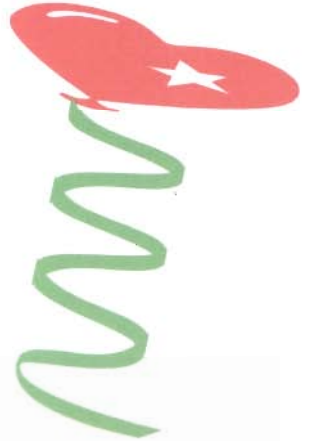




# Apostles Lutheran Preschool

## January 26 -28, 2010



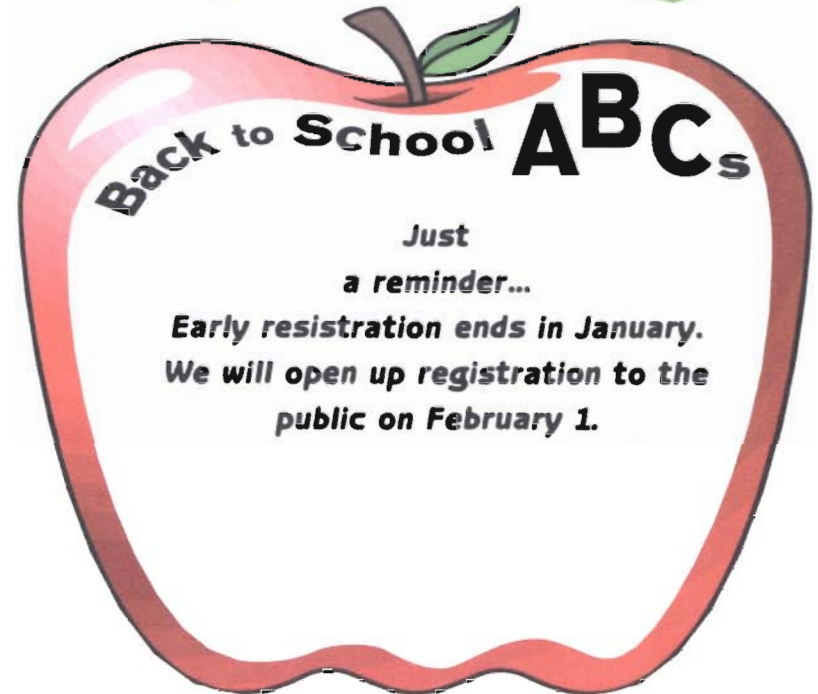
