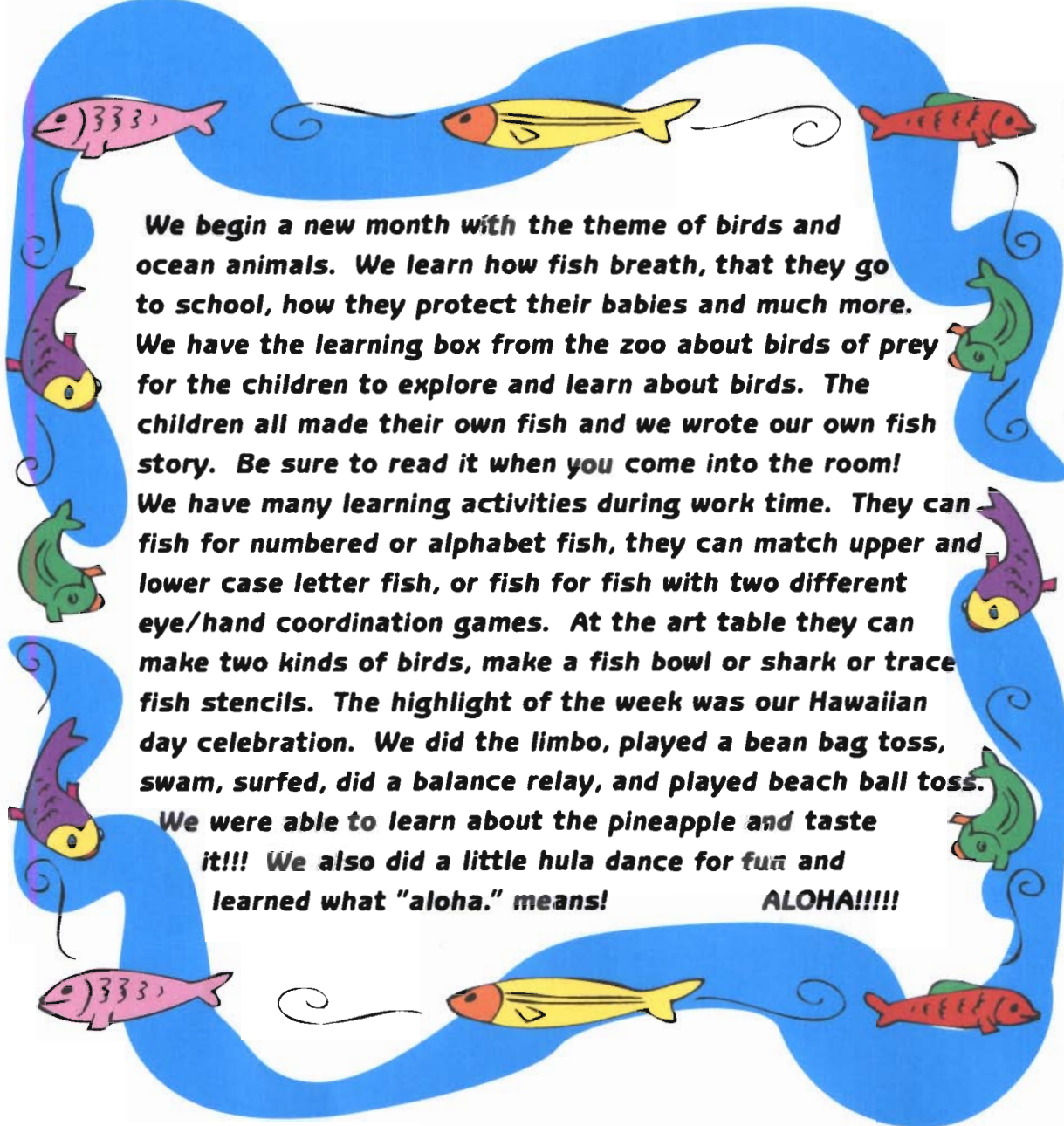




Apostles Lutheran Preschool
