**It is fall even though the temperature still feels like summer. We learned about the different signs of fall - the leaves changing color, the birds flying south, the leaves, acorns and pinecones falling on the ground and how the nights are getting colder. We then learned why the leaves change and fall from the tree and why they grow back. The children were able to paint leaves, sponge paint a tree, and make fall wreaths at the art center. They were also able to do a leaf color match and a fall patterning game in the math and manipulative center.**

**We began the letter of the week with "Ff". The children listened to the sound it makes, made the letter with their hand and tried to come up with words that began with it. On Wednesday the morning class made foam "Ff's" out of shaving cream.**

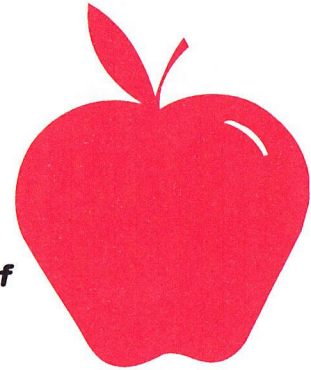
