It is a fun way to learn colors and practice listening. We had fun learning about colors. We learned with the help of a wonderful book called Mouse Paint that if you mix certain colors you get new colors. We then tried it out with red, yellow and blue water. Ask your child what color red and yellow make, what color yellow and blue make and then what color blue and red make. You can have a fun experiment together at home with food coloring, just be careful as it stains. We played color games, made rainbows and patterned with the rainbow stackers during work time.

The letter of the week was "Rr". On Wednesday we made rainbow R's out of cereal. Thursday we enjoy rainbow cereal for snack.

In the Bible lesson this week we learned about Noah and his family. We heard how they were the only eight people in the world who loved God. Ask your child what God told Noah to build? (ark) What did God tell Noah to fill the ark with? (two of every animal, food, and his family) How many days did it rain? (40) When everything dried up God told Noah and his family to come out of the ark. What was the first thing they did? (Give thanks to God for saving them.) Then God promised never to flood the whole world again and gave them a sign what was the sign? (a rainbow) The Bible treasure - "God wants all people to be saved." He showed us by sending Jesus to save us all.
