Personal Safety was the theme for this week. Police Officer Zorzakis was to visit but unfortunately a mandatory training and a work related call made that an impossibility. He will visit us later in the year when we do community helpers. That however did not stop our learning. We learned that a police officer is our friend and is there to help us. We learned about some of the things they carry on their uniform and different ways they travel (car, horse, bike, motorbike, boat and walk). We watched a movie with Eddie the Eagle who teaches gun safety. He taught us "STOP! Don't touch, leave the area, tell an adult." We also used this verse with other things we shouldn't touch if we find them such as matches, knives and medicine. We also heard about stranger danger and learned how to call 911. The most important part of learning to call 911 is that you can only call in an EMERGENCY!

The letter this week was a hard one "Xx". The children were able to make the sound and sign it, but coming up with "x" words is hard. Thanks to everyone's hard work to get some up on the wall. On Wednesday we made "x's" with our bodies.

In our Bible lesson this week we hear how God protected baby Moses. God's people lived where there was an evil king. The king did not love God or His people. The king made them slaves that had to do all the work. God, however, loved them and they continued to grow. Ask your child how that made the king feel (mad). He became so mad that he told God's people they had to do what with their baby boys? (throw them in the river) When Moses was born his mother hid him until he got big and noisy, but she didn't want to throw him in the river so what did she put him in? (a basket) Who found baby Moses? (princess) God made sure someone found Moses that would protect him and let his mom watch him. God loves and protects us too! Bible treasure - "I am with you always!"

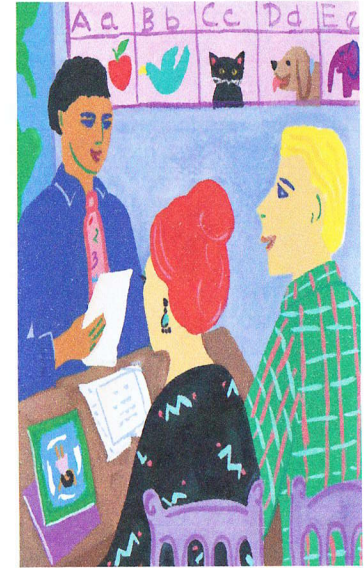


Parent/teacher Conferences
