We begin by learning that a pumpkin begins from a seed that is planted, it grows on a vine that has flowers that change to pumpkins. When the pumpkin is ripe it is orange and ready to be picked. We then dissected our own pumpkin to see what was inside. It was slimy and gooey and had lots of seeds. We cleaned the pumpkins and Mr. Scott carved them. We did not plant seeds, but we baked them and tried them for snack; a yummy and nutritious treat. We were able to play several math games with pumpkins, lace pumpkins, sponge and easel paint pumpkins and bats, use fishing nets to catch pumpkins in the water and design our own pumpkins all during work time. We also made special Halloween pumpkins for our families. Hope you enjoy them.**

**The letter this week was "Hh". We learned the sign and made the sound and did our cheer. On Wednesday we hopped through hoola hoops to reinforce the "Hh" sound.**

**In our Bible lesson this week, we heard the story of Moses now that he is all grown up. He went to live with the mean King's daughter as the mother promised in last weeks lesson. The king of Egypt was still mean to God's people. Moses tried to get the king to let them go, but the king just made them work harder. God finally gets the king to let His people go. God had Moses lead them out of Egypt. God showed them which way to go by a what in the day and a what in the night? (a cloud and a cloud of fire) They camped by the Red Sea. Back in Egypt what did the king decide to do? (send soldiers to bring them back) How did God's people feel when they saw the soldier? (afraid) They prayed to God and what happened? (the water opened up and they went through on dry land) What happened when the soldiers tried to go through? (the water covered them) Who protected God's people? (God) Our Bible treasure - "Call on me in the day of trouble." God still protects us too!**
