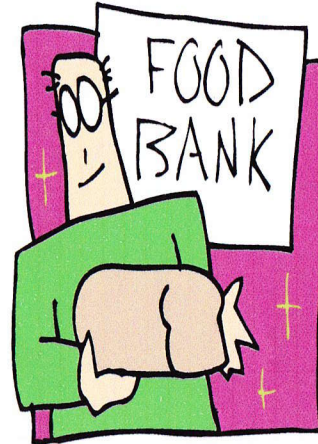


Food Drive
