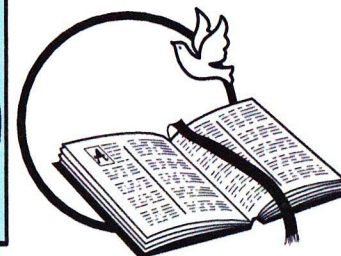
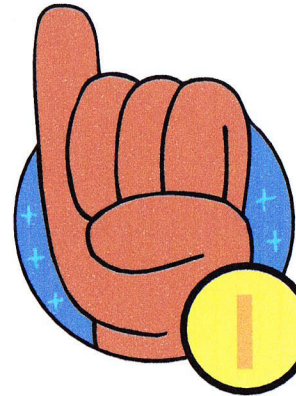
There will be refreshments served after the program.
