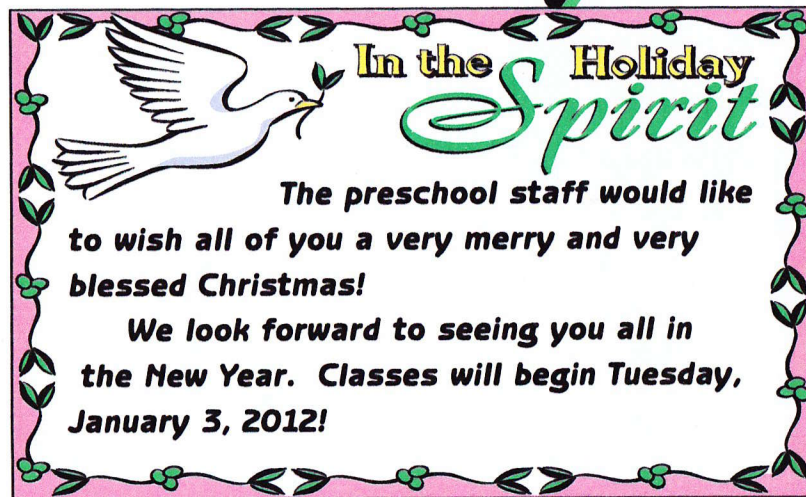
December 20 - 22, 2011
