The children were definitely on the move as we studied transportation this week. We first learned that transportation is how we get from one place to another. We then put our brains to work brainstorming all the different types of transportation we could! The children had many enrichment opportunities during work time, some of the choices were flying a jet fighter, doing tire track art, making a rocketship, practicing math skills with matching, patterning, counting and sequencing games, floating boats and playing with different types of vehicles. We concluded the unit by writing a train story. This is an add on story which is a great early literacy exercise.

The letter for the week was "Tt". We saw that the capital and small "T" do not look the same, but they sound the same. We practice signing and making the sound. On Wednesday we made tasty tortilla rollups and did a fun gross motor activity called "Tooty Ta"!

In the Bible lesson we learned about a man named John. John wore camel skin clothes and ate grasshoppers and honey, but the important thing he did was tell people they were sinners. He then told them about their Savior and those who were sorry for their sins were baptized. He used water and God's Word to baptize them and they were then children of God's. Ask your child who came to have John baptize Him. (Jesus) John knew Jesus had never sinned, but Jesus said He must do as His Father commands. John baptized Jesus and then what happened? (The Holy Spirit appeared in the shape of a dove and God from heaven said "This is my Son with who I am well pleased!")

In your child's folder you will find a letter and registration sheet for next year!

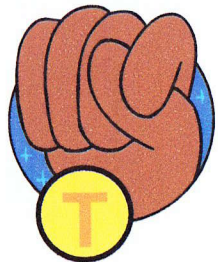
If you would like to join us again in the fall or have a sibling that would like to begin, please fill out the form and return by January 31.
